



ADVERTISING ON SCHOOL PREMISES POLICY

Acceptance of advertising from external providers by display of a poster or flyer is at the discretion of the Head Teacher. We DO NOT do 'bag drops' for the distribution of magazines, leaflets or flyers.

Should the decision be made to accept advertising in principle, the decision regarding what can and cannot be advertised is also at the discretion of the Head Teacher.

For a fee of £3.00 per week or £15.00 per short term (approximately 6 weeks), Boyne Hill CE Infant and Nursery School will display a small poster or flyer, maximum size A4, on one or more external notice boards, subject to availability of space, for an agreed period.

Examples of material not permitted to be displayed at the school:

- Party political material
- Any material which may cause offence to others
- Any unlawful material or that which is in breach of any Statutory Act such as the Race Relations Act
- Advertisements for money-lending services, tobacco, alcohol, illegal goods or services
- Any material from external providers which advertise or promote academic support for children, e.g. maths or English classes
- Any other material which is considered unsuitable by the school

Implementation of the Policy

The Head teacher, Office Manager and the Bursar have responsibility for implementing this policy. All material coming into school for display is subject to approval by the Head Teacher. Approval may be withdrawn at any time without notice.

Areas to which the Policy applies

All areas of the school buildings and grounds are subject to this Policy.

This policy will be reviewed biennially
