ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY

THE SCHOOL WILL:

Register children promptly at 8.55am

Carefully consider any requests for term time absence for children in Foundation Stage 2 and Key Stage 1, in line with our Attendance policy

AS PARENT/CARER I WILL:

Make sure that my child arrives at school and is collected on time every day and **NOT take holidays during term time**

Try to make any medical appointments outside of the school day

Let the school know if someone else is picking my child up

Contact the school promptly if my child is going to be absent

BEHAVIOUR

THE SCHOOL WILL:

Make sure that the children are familiar with our three school rules

Use rewards and sanctions fairly

Ensure that school staff always set a high standard of personal behaviour

Show respect for everyone in our school community

AS PARENT/CARER I WILL:
