Guidelines

In order to support your child's preparation for this, please help them to choose a favourite story and practise reading aloud a passage from it, the length of which is up to them, but suiting their reading ability and own comfort.

Practise hints

- ❖ Tell the listener the title and author
- ❖ Hold the book up firmly to read
- ❖ Read clearly so that you can be heard
- ❖ Show understanding of the sense
- ❖ Show interest by use of expression
